Inner-Work Pilgrimage

Experience the objective art of the wisdom way on pilgrimage, including the magical rolling hills of Northwestern Spain, a sacred mass in the cathedral of Santiago de Compostela and half-day visit to the pre-Christian, Celtic and Roman pilgrimage destination of Finisterre (literally meaning and, once widely considered to be, 'the end of the earth').



Inner-Work Pilgrimage

- · Join a group of inner-work practitioners walking the final 100km of the Camino Frances from Sarria to Santiago de Compostela.
- · Includes: 3 nights of hotel stays in Madrid and 2 nights stay in Santiago de Compostela as well as hotel/pensiones across Galicia over the course of 6 days on the Camino including 5 days of walking an average of 13 miles per/day.
- · Includes backpack transport services between towns, meals over the course of 11 daysbeginning with dinner on February 28 and ending with dinner on March 9.
- · Mini-bus/train transportation services between major cities in Spain.
- · Expert guidance and local knowledge.
- · A visit to the mythical Costa da Morte in Finisterre.
